ADMISSION METHODOLOGY – MASTER'S PROGRAM IN SUSTAINABLE ENERGY AND MOBILITY SYSTEMS

Admission Process

Admission to the Sustainable Energy and Mobility Systems master's program is based on a competitive oral examination.

Admission Components

The admission interview consists of two oral components:

- Component 1 – Assessment of the candidate's motivation to pursue the master's program (contributes to grade M1).

- Component 2 – Assessment of the candidate's fundamental and specialized knowledge in the field (contributes to grade M2).

The list of topics for Component 2 is published on the official admission website of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering.

Oral Admission Grade (MO)

The oral admission grade is calculated as:

MO = (M1 + M2) / 2

The result is rounded to two decimal places without rounding up.

Final Admission Grade (MG)

The final admission grade used for candidate ranking is calculated as:

MG = (MO + ML) / 2

Where:

- MO – oral admission grade

- ML – final grade obtained in the bachelor's degree program

Ranking and Tie-breaking Criteria

Candidates will be ranked according to their final admission grade (MG).

In case of a tie, the oral admission grade (MO) will be used as the first tie-breaker.

Language Proficiency Requirement

As the program is taught entirely in English, all candidates must take a language proficiency test in English. This test is eliminatory and graded as Pass/Fail.

Exemptions from the language test apply to candidates who:

- have graduated from a university-level study program (bachelor or master) taught in English;

- hold official diplomas or academic transcripts issued by institutions where the language of instruction was English.

Applicable Regulations

All candidates are subject to the <u>General Admission Regulations for Master's Studies</u>, academic <u>year 2025–2026</u>, as approved by the University of Craiova.
